- **Conclusions** concerning the influence of the activities covered on the future of paper recycling, especially with regard to bottlenecks, limitations and potentials

E48 Summary report

- **Scenarios** for the future of paper recycling based on
 - Results of questionnaires etc
 - Model based calculations
 - Discussions at the meetings
- **Overall conclusions**
 - What are the critical factors and limits for paper recycling now and in the future?
 - What can be done to push the limits forwards?

The responsibility for

- The WG reports is with the WG leaders
- The summary report is with the Steering Group
- Writing of articles etc is with everyone
- Creation of new projects and research activities is with everyone

How to develop the reports

- Create Task Forces within the WGs or around other specific tasks
- Try to involve as many Action participants as possible in the process; preparing the reports should not be the job of single WG leaders alone!
